GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2009 NJASC State Officers will lead the New Jersey delegation to the 73rd annual NASC National Conference from June 26-July 1 in Denver, Colorado. Our delegation of 35-40 students and advisers from throughout the state will join over one thousand others from across the United States and Canada for an unforgettable leadership experience. At this time the adviser of each State Officer is cordially invited to join our delegation...

The overall cost for this trip is given below. Please note that your school is fully expected to cover the cost for participation in the NASC National Conference by its State Officer, as part of the obligation your Principal and Superintendent agreed to when signing the application for he or she to become a candidate.

State Officers/Administrative Assistants **\$1060.00***

The reduced cost is due to the fact that NJASC pays the NASC Conference Registration fee of \$415.00 for these students.

Students **\$1475.00***

Students will stay in the hotel throughout the entire conference and pre/post-trip, with 3 or 4 to a room.

Advisers **\$1595.00***

Advisers will stay in the hotel throughout the entire conference and pre/post-trip, with 2 to a room. Depending on availability, we may be able to offer advisers a single room for \$375.00 extra.
