GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2012 NJASC State Officers will lead our New Jersey delegation trip to the 2012 NASC National Conference from June 22-27 in Oklahoma City. Our delegation of about twenty student leaders and advisers from throughout our state will join nearly one thousand of their peers from the United States (and beyond) for a truly unforgettable leadership experience. The adviser of each State Officer is cordially invited to join our delegation – the overall cost for this trip is given below.

NOTE: *For State Officers, your school is expected to financially support your participation in our state delegation to the NASC National Conference as part of the obligation agreed to by your Principal and Superintendent when signing the application to run for State Office.*

Students (including State Officers, AAs)

\$1,475.00*

Students will stay in the hotel throughout the entire conference and pre/post-trip. We have reserved 2 bedroom suites, each with 3 beds and a pullout, in which we will place 6-8 students.

Advisers

\$1,575.00*

Advisers will stay in the hotel throughout the entire conference and pre/post-trip. We have reserved 2 bedroom suites, each with 3 beds and a pullout, in which we will place 2-4 advisers.
