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## **PROVIDE A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THIS PROJECT:**

Don't let the name deceive you, this is an activity everyone can participate in! Loud music, food, friends, and basketball is what this event is all about. The 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> graders are allowed up to 6 people on one team. You may have a combination of kids from any grade but you must have co-ed teams. Each team pays \$5 to play, which goes toward food and water, and the rest goes to Spread the Magic, our state charity. That is a brief description of our 3on3 Basketball Tournament.
