Rules Regarding Hallway Halloween:

To ensure a safe, healthy environment for all of our trick-or-treaters, we ask that you adhere to the following rules:

- If helping with the event, you must be at Absegami High School no later than 5:45 PM, preferably between the hours of 5-5:45 pm to help your club/sport or activity set up for the evening.
- Those participating must
 - (1) Sign in for the evening between 5-5:45 in the atrium
 - (2) Receive and wear a name tag
- If you are at the event without having done either of the steps above, and are without a child in grades K-4th, you will be asked to leave the premises.
- The fire doors in the hallways are not to be closed for any reasons, not even for decorating purposes.
- Please avoid sugary treats and snacks. Also beware of treats with nuts in them!! Children may have allergies we are unaware of.
- No appliances will be permitted in setups
- If your club/sport/ or activity is in need to use any electrical outlet, you must notify Mrs. Sharpe or Ms. Salotti to be approved before plugging ANYTHING into an outlet.
- If your club/sport or activity wishes to wear costumes for your activity, it is permitted; however, please notify Mrs. Sharpe or Ms. Salotti of what you will be wearing.
- In all instances, use clear judgment, awareness and responsibility if questionable make a new plan
