

Homecoming

Flowers:

**Call florist 2-3 weeks prior to the date of Homecoming.
Inform florist of your color scheme (should be seasonally appropriate)**

**You will order: corsages for all the nominees,
boutonnieres for their escorts, One large bouquet
for the winner, a medium bouquet for the runner
up, and 3 small bouquets for the other girls.**

**You will need a person to pick the flowers up from the
florist on the day of Homecoming.**

Need a person to hand out the flowers

*** inform the nominees of a specific time and place to meet
prior to everything so that the process of
attaching flowers will go more smoothly**

Crown and Sash:

Buy a crown at a party store

Sash must say Homecoming Queen and year

***A person on the homecoming committee's mother made it
this year. Nice, simple, and costs nothing!**

Script:

Find a person with good announcing personality

**Must write a script for the announcer to read (biographies
of the girls)**

Biographies of the girls:

Give girls sheets to fill in relative information

**Who will be escorting them on homecoming day, school
activities they participate in, what they do in their
free time, where they hope to go to college/what**

they plan on studying.

Have someone write up about a paragraph on each girl

Pictures:

Take a group shot of the girls

This year, a student with a good quality camera took the pictures, and a teacher developed them to make the pictures 8"X11"

Take a shot of each girl individually

Our setting was natural (girls posed leaning against tree). We decorated a cork board with nice paper and decorations and hung all the pictures and biographies on it.

Voting:

For Nominees: print out a list of all senior girls and let all senior boys vote

For Homecoming Queen: make ballot of the nominees and allow everyone to vote during lunches

Contact last year's winner or runner up to present the new winner with her crown, sash, and bouquet.
